Rehearsal and Production Schedule
Rehearsals are Monday thru Thursday 7 PM – 9:30 PM, and Sundays at 10:30 AM to 1:30 PM.
Rehearsals begin with a readthru on Sunday, January 2, at 10:30 AM.
Performances begin Friday, January 28, and will continue Friday and Saturday nights as well as Sunday matinees for four weekends, ending on Sunday, February 20. All actors are required to help strike on Sunday, February 20, after the matinee performance.
n.b. Candidates for the roles of SHE/Ada, HE/Johnny, Director, Millicent/Laurie, Harrison/Husband, and Kevin will need to be comfortable kissing someone of the opposite or same sex. <u>Please read the <i>Stage Kiss</i> production's copy of Health and Safety policies & procedures.</u>

- 1) You must show proof that you have been <u>fully</u> vaccinated against COVID. You must show this to me or to Suzanne Couch. If you do not have your card with you today, you may scan or take a photo of your card and text it to 719-588-1155 or email it to <u>psnewman@adams.edu</u>. Only fully vaccinated actors will be considered for a role in *Stage Kiss*. This policy means that casting will be determined slightly later than usual.
- 2) Because rehearsals on Sundays are three hours long, we will begin each Sunday rehearsal with a self-administered rapid COVID test. There will be no cost to you. If you test positive, you will be excused from rehearsal and will need to quarantine for 10 days.
- 3) Actors and crew will need to assess their health on a daily basis. If you are feeling sick, we will have you take a self-administered rapid COVID test before rehearsal. There will be no cost to you. If your test is negative, and you are coming down with something such as a cold, we will ask you to mask up for the rehearsal. And your character's kissing scenes will be suspended until you are healthy.
- 4) There are no understudies for your role. Please be aware that altho we cannot push the production's opening back on the calendar due to sickness, we will cancel performances if an actor is sick with COVID or flu. Therefore, it is important that you monitor your wellness. Don't "walk it off." We would rather cancel a performance or a weekend of performances than to endanger the cast/crew.
- 5) Because there is a lot of kissing in *Stage Kiss* (see audition form), the actors cast for SHE and HE will not kiss until the second week of rehearsal. Other actors will not kiss other actors until the third week of rehearsal. Other actors are encouraged to develop "Creative Kissing" improvs.
- 6) Your audition form will ask you to read these policy and procedure conditions and sign that you have read and agree to these conditions. We are living in an unusual time. That we are permitted to bring our art to a physically present audience means we must take extraordinary precautions. If you cannot agree to these precautions, please inform me or Suzanne Couch. You will be excused from auditions.
